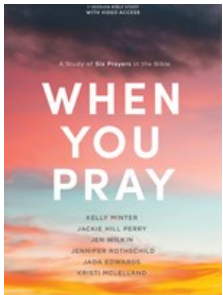




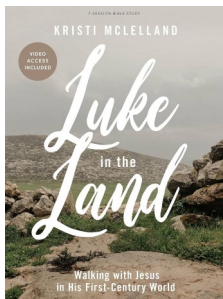

Do you have trouble thinking of words to say to God when you pray? Are you afraid some emotions are too intense to express to God? Do you reach the end of a day only to realize you haven't prayed at all? You're not alone. In this 7-session study, six beloved Bible teachers will help you study prayers in the Bible. Learn that God welcomes your praise, lament, thanksgiving and intercession. See examples of how to pray when you're alone and when gathered with others. Above all, you'll notice there's no one right way to pray. As you draw near to God through prayer, you'll find your faith strengthened and your heart united to Christ.

- ◆ Explore the different types of prayer modeled in Scripture.
- ◆ Understand how prayer unites believers to God and to one another.
- ◆ Learn how to overcome struggles that keep you from talking to God.

- ◆ Explore cultural and historical concepts that will give new perspective.
